Steps to Success



I can adapt my language appropriate to the audience.

I can confidently produce a minimum of 20+ sentences (speaking/writing) unaided.

I can use 4 time frames.

My work only contains minor errors.

I can use grammar in new situations.

I can confidently produce a minimum of 15/20 sentences (speaking / writing) unaided.

I can use 3 time frames.

I can use a wide range of opinions.

I can use a range of connectives (while / however / when)

I can justify my opinions with more complex structures.

My verb and tense formation are nearly always accurate and sometimes I make mistakes in more complex structures.

I can transfer my knowledge of grammar to different contexts.

I can confidently produce a minimum of 12/15 sentences (speaking / writing) unaided.

I can use 2 time frames.

I can use some opinions.

I can use some connectives.

I can begin to justify my opinions.

My verb and tense formation are accurate.

I can transfer my knowledge of grammar to different contexts.

I can confidently produce a minimum of 8/10 sentences (speaking/writing) unaided.

I can use 1 time frame with all pronouns.

I can use some opinions.

I can use some connectives.

I can begin to justify my opinions.

My verb formations are nearly always correct.

I can usually transfer my knowledge of grammar to different contexts.

I can confidently produce a minimum of 5/7 sentences (speaking/writing) unaided.

I can use 1 time frame with "I".

I can use basic opinions.

I can use but, and, because and or.

Verbs and tense formations are sometimes correct.

I can sometimes transfer my knowledge of grammar to different contexts.

I can confidently produce a minimum of 2/3 sentences (speaking/writing) aided.

I can give 1 opinion.

I sometimes form my verbs correctly.

I am starting to transfer my knowledge of grammar to different contexts.
