# GCSE Exam Results 2019

John Mason School is celebrating a rise in standards for the fourth year running under the leadership of Headteacher Sarah Brinkley who joined the school in 2015, with 43% of students achieving 9-5 in both English and maths, which is a higher grade than the previous A\*-C measure. We are also exceeding national averages with the % of students gaining grades 9-7 (equivalent to A\*/A) in both of these subjects.

TeamJMS are very pleased to report that English has attained 75.4% the equivalent of A\* - C, as well as 21.4% of students gaining grade 9-7 (A\*/A). In addition, maths has continued its steady rise with a result this year and 24.3% of students achieved grades 9-7 (A\*/A). Similarly, science has continued to build on the success of last year, with 68% of students gaining 9-4 (A\*-C) which is substantially higher than the national average.

The majority of subjects performed the same or better than last year, including English, Maths, sciences, history, geography, art, textiles, graphics, 3D design and computing. These results reflect the hard work and determination of staff, students and their families. We are, as ever, extremely proud of our students.

The results this year reflect a huge amount of hard work and effort on behalf of our staff, students and their families.

This is an excellent set of results at a time of educational instability – with no alternative qualifications – just great teaching and learning.

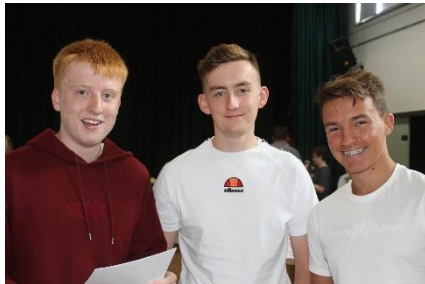


# A Level Exam Results 2019
