



Dear families,

This letter is to give you some more information about our educational provision this week. As previously communicated, we currently have a reduced capacity for students on site at John Mason School and so we have made the following arrangements:

Years 11, 12 and 13

Years 12 and Year 13 will have all their lessons moved to Fitzharrys School for the week. Year 11 will return to school tomorrow and will follow their normal timetable, with room changes. Timetabled lessons for these year groups have not changed – only the location has changed.

Years 7-10

Year 7 – Year 10 will have a combination of 1 day in school and 3 days working from home.

- Year 10 will be in school on Wednesday.
- Year 9 will be in school on Thursday.
- Year 8 will be in school on Friday.
- Year 7 will be in school on Tuesday.

Students should use their timetable to check the resources they need for each day, such as their PE kit. We understand that some students will have resources stored in lockers in areas of the school that they will not be able to access and so we understand that they may not be able to wear their usual JMS kit.
