Parent Bulletin

Dear families,

Winter has arrived in Abingdon. I enjoy the opportunity to share our students' fantastic achievements in this bulletin each week, whether they be sporting, creative or academic. I'm not sure which category the JMS snowman fits into here but well done to those who arrived early on Monday morning and set to work. The early opening of a lunchbox to retrieve two blueberries for eyes was perhaps the most inspired move!

Aside from the excitement of snow falling, it has been a very cold week. Please can I remind you to make sure your child arrives in school wearing their school jumper (non-school jumpers are not allowed) and a warm coat. On dry days, whilst we do have the Main Hall open with plenty of seating,



most students spend their breaks and lunches outside once they have finished eating and the school site has lots of outdoor spaces which students need to cross between lessons.

You may have already seen my letter, sent this morning, consulting on changes to the school day. Whilst the proposed changes are small, we hope they can all have a positive impact on students' education. Please use the link in the letter to let us know your thoughts and to help us make a final decision.

In October we conducted a Parent Survey in which we asked you your opinions around the impact of smartphones on the school community. In your responses 52.7% said that you believe that smartphones are harmful to young people, while 3.6% of you said you thought they were not.

The comments you shared were very useful. You talked about the importance of clear boundaries, education, and the dangers of social media. Some of you asked for a total ban in schools while others pointed out the challenges of a ban would create. We are currently reflecting carefully on your responses as well as reviewing the research on the impact smartphones can have on young people's mental health and wellbeing and looking at strategies being used by schools around the country to meet these challenges. We will keep you updated with any changes we make to our approach to dealing with smartphones in school.

I hope you have a good weekend and manage to stay warm.
