Homework

Students in years 7-11 are set homework through Bromcom. Using MCAS or the Student Portal, the specific details of each homework can be viewed.

Timetables for each year group which show the days on which each subject will be due can be found on the school website https://www.johnmason.oxon.sch.uk/homework/

You can also find, a timetable of 'Homework Support Sessions' where students can go to get subject specific help with their homework. Year 12 and 13 students have independent work set via Google Classrooms.

If your child misses the deadline for their homework, their teacher will log a missed homework event on Bromcom so that you are aware. Students in year 10 and 11 will need to attend a catch-up session at lunchtime to ensure the homework is completed as they cannot afford to fall behind with their exam courses.
